Trade Contractors should submit a detailed, itemized Change Order Proposal (CPO) that covers additional work and/or deleted work originating through Architects or Engineers Supplemental Instructions (ASI or ESI), field directives and Owner or Consultant Construction Change Directives (CCD).

Avoid conflicting clauses in the contract regarding change orders. If the contract states the contractor can't commence work on any changes without a written change order, there shouldn't be language stating that the owner can order extra work to be performed without a compensation agreement.

The original contract can set out a fee for change orders or limit the number of change orders that can be submitted before extra charges are incurred. Contractors may also want to note in the contract that they are not responsible for project delays caused by change orders.
